A Message from Father



Rejoice Always!

Today's second reading (I Thessalonians 5.16-24) emphasizes the theme for the Third Sunday of Advent: "Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit..."

At times, we are discouraged. We are told to give thanks in all circumstances. When our tour group was in Israel, war broke out. This Scripture passage was a source of hope. I was thankful to be safe. I was thankful that we were still able to do some touring of important religious sites. I was thankful that we had a plan to return home. I

was thankful for all the prayers and support we received. The Lord took care of us. Let us rejoice!

Let us rejoice! Let us give thanks in any and all circumstances. When we do this, the Advent spirit of high hopes and great expectations will dominate our lives. Our lives will witness to the Christ who brings His Light to the world.

As mentioned earlier, the brick work has ended for this year and will resume next spring as weather permits. It is estimated there is 30 weeks of brick work yet to be completed.

Work is still being done on the roof, including insulation. The metal shingles are in two large containers and have been shipped to our property. It will be installed next summer. Insulation is also being done inside the church. Window openings will be covered in preparation for heating inside the new church. After the heat is on, work is able to continue in the church. The bolts in the rafters will be painted. Currently, they are metal gray.

The countertop in the Bride's Room is yet to be installed. A refrigerator has been ordered for that room. Painting and touchups are being done in the new office addition. We hope to occupy the new office addition next week.





Cathedral Solemn Vespers | December 17-23 at 7 PM

All are welcome to pray and sing vespers each evening from December 17th to 23rd at 7 PM in Our Lady of Guadalupe Adoration Chapel at the Cathedral at 615 7th Street North in Fargo. The Church eagerly awaits the coming of the Messiah and sings the "O Antiphons" which recall various prophetic titles of the Christ: O Wisdom, O Lord, O Root of Jesse, O Key of David, O Radiant Dawn, O King of the Nations, O Emmanuel.


