A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



A Great Day for our Parish!

Last Wednesday was a historic day for our parish. The top part of the 50,000 lb+ steeple was set into place. Many parishioners, school children, Parish and School Staffs and friends of Holy Cross watched this happen. It was heartwarming to see onlookers watch with excitement and joy.

Our steeple, including the 6 foot stainless steel Cross is 138 feet tall! Within 10 minutes the steeple was raised and set into place. 16 bolts were used to fasten the base and the top part of the steeple. Welding and reinforcements will also be used to secure the structure.

This day was made possible because of the support of our parishioners, Bishop Folda, the Diocese of Fargo, Fr Jim Meyer, our former pastor and friends of Holy Cross Parish. Gratitude is also extended to Earl Wilhelm, the Properties Manager for the Diocese of Fargo, Tyler Blaine, the Construction Manager, all the contractors and workers.

The interior of our new church is heated to about 40 degrees. Workers are installing installation and setting up rooms such as our two confessionals.
