A Message from Father



"Everyone is Looking For You!"

In today's Gospel (Mark 1.29-39), Jesus was leaving the synagogue and went to Simon Peter's house. Peter's mother-in-law was ill. Jesus cured her. That evening, the whole town gathered at His door. He cured many people and drove out demons.

He rose early the next morning and went to a deserted place to pray. Simon and some others found Jesus and said to Him, "Everyone is looking for you." Jesus left with them to move on to neighboring villages to preach and to drive out demons.

Key point: we are to look for Jesus. We are to seek Him out. We are to spend time with Him in prayer. Otherwise, we are miserable.

Speaking of being miserable, I was reading an article on rules to keep one's self miserable and make others miserable:

Feel sorry for yourself.

Worry. Focus on things that might happen but won't.

Complain. Find fault with everything.

Insist on having things your own way.

Ridicule. Make someone else miserable as yourself.

Overreact. Make a mountain out of a molehill.

Be self-centered.

Ignore the moral teachings of the Church. Adopt the principle "I'll do it my way."

Deny! Convince yourself that you are self-sufficient; not needing compassion, forgiveness and understanding. Prayer and Mass are mere incidentals.

In our faith, we are taught just one rule: Search for Him! As human beings, have a deep longing for God. Having a deep, intimate relationship with God will bring us genuine happiness. The One true God shows us His deep love and concern for us. Jesus can satisfy that deep longing.

There are nine rules to become miserable. With Christ, there is one rule for happiness and fulfillment: "Love one another as I have loved you."

Building Project Update (after our January 24th Weekly Construction Meeting)

We are enjoying the use of our new office addition. Fr Karmal and Fr Lorsung moved into their new offices. We are working on getting office door and meeting door locks installed in the office addition.

At the north end of the new hallway, a temporary insulated wall has been put in place to keep that end of the building warm during the winter; and to keep it cool during the hot months of summer. The wall will be removed when the new church is nearly completed.

Insulation and sheetrock are being installed in various parts of the church. We hope to have the floor heat up and running very soon. Piping in the main church area on the high ceiling level (fire sprinkling system) is complete. But other areas of piping need to be installed.

Stairs are being installed in the steeple tower.


