A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Our Parish Mission Begins Today!

We invite you to set aside time for our Parish Mission entitled “Repent, Reboot, Resolve.” Dcn Ben Seitz, father of Fr Eric Seitz will be our Spiritual Director. Sessions are Sunday at 2:00 PM; Monday and Tuesday at 7:00 PM. This is a wonderful opportunity to attend the Parish Mission as part of our Lenten observance.

A Change of Heart

A priest who served as chaplain at the Kentucky State Penitentiary shares about a prisoner on death row. His cell was two floors above the electric chair.

The prisoner’s name is Paul. He asked the priest if he could receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and receive Communion. They met several times. As a result, the priest became acquainted with other Catholic inmates on death row.

Paul had been taking correspondence courses on topics such as Old Testament, New Testament, Church history, Church teachings, morality and catechetics. He became a certified catechist for the diocese and conducts an RCIA program.

Paul reached out to other inmates and brought them to embrace a new found faith.

Paul had a change of heart. The priest asked him how that happened. He said that four things led him to a deeper faith:

1. Letting go of things that bothered him.
2. Meditating daily.
3. Reading the Scriptures.
4. Sharing his life with other prisoners.

How many of us do that? The Season of Lent is a great opportunity to foster our faith for a deeper change of heart.

When Jesus Christ is a part of our lives, remarkable things happen!

Building Project Update (as of the February 21st Construction Meeting)

Huesman Schreiber Masonry will return to work on the entry cast stone starting Monday, March 4th. Space is needed in the parking lot for 2 semi-truck loads of cast stone that is being delivered next Friday. They have an estimated 30 weeks installation for brick and cast stone plus cast cap install time once they are full strength in the spring.

Cullen Insulation has completed spray foam insulation in the church except for final touchups and scraping That will be completed this week. They will spray foam exterior walls in the tower after framing and sheathing.

TK Elevator delivered the elevator some time ago. The Bus Barn is being utilized for storage until needed next summer.

The second layer of Insulation on the exterior roof has been completed.

Work is being done on the bell tower.

Church floor heat (heating coil system below the floor) ready to be activated.


