Forgiving the Sinner

Today's Gospel presents the powerful story of Jesus forgiving the woman caught in adultery. While others pointed fingers and accused her of her sins, Jesus chose a path of mercy and second chances.

He calls us to follow His example — to forgive others, heal broken lives, and restore them to His love and friendship.

The readings today challenge us to offer the same mercy to those around us. We are reminded to live as people who have been forgiven, seeking reconciliation with both God and each other. The central theme of all three readings is the unwavering love of a merciful God. They warn us not to be self-righteous or quick to condemn others, especially when God is gently calling them to conversion.

We must become people who forgive, ready for reconciliation. Jesus has shown boundless mercy and compassion by dying for our sins. Yet, like the Pharisees, we can often be self-righteous, quick to gossip or judge others. Whether it's the unmarried mother, the alcoholic, the drug addict, or the shoplifter, we may be ready to condemn, forgetting Jesus' words: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

Let us remember to acknowledge our own sins, seek God's forgiveness daily, and extend the same forgiveness to our brothers and sisters. We are called to hate the sin but love the sinner, showing them Jesus' compassion. By working with the Holy Spirit, we can make our own lives an example, helping lead others to Jesus' way.

We Have No Right to Judge Others

We have no right to judge because often, we commit the very faults we condemn. We can be partial, prejudiced in our judgments, and unaware of the circumstances that have led others to sin. Let us leave judgment to our merciful God, who knows the hearts of all. We are all sinners in need of His forgiveness. As the Apostle Paul reminds us, "But if we judged ourselves, we would not come under judgment." (1 Cor 11:31).

Let us forgive others, just as we seek forgiveness for ourselves.
