### **CHRISM MASS**

On Tuesday, April 4th the Chrism Mass will be held at St. Mary's Cathedral at 11:00 am. There will be NO Daily Mass held at Holy Cross, or any other church in the Diocese that day.

Here the Bishop blesses three oils - the oil of catechumens, the oil of the infirm, and holy chrism - which will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the Diocese for the year.

The Cantor has the responsibility for any songs or hymns that require solo passages, leading the assembly, and inviting the assembly in hymns and acclamations used throughout Mass. The requirements to be a successful Cantor include a strong singing voice, ability to encourage the people to join in the songs and dedication to the ministry of music. This ministry is open to high school/adult singers.
