Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Holy Day of Obligation Tuesday, August 15th

On August 15th we celebrate "The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven" at the end of her earthly life. The Feast of the Assumption is a very old feast of the Church, celebrated universally since the sixth century. It commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven, before her body could begin to decay- - a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is the most important of all Marian feasts.


