I pray these words find all doing well. All is going well here at Incarnation central. It really is amazing to realize that school is over, and we have approached summer mode. It has been such a crazy time, but it feels like we are finally turning a corner. I have been vaccinated but still wear a mask at times during Mass for those people who are still in masks themselves (due to being cautious or because they have chosen not to get vaccinated.) The Peter's Pence Collection occurs yearly on the Sunday closest to June 29, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, as a sign that Catholics around the world are joined together in support of the Holy Father.

A Concrete Sign of Mercy

The concrete participation in the needs of the universal ecclesial community has taken different forms throughout history. Collections and donations by the individual faithful or entire local churches raise awareness that all the baptized are called to materially sustain the work of evangelization and, at the same time, to help the poor in whatever way possible. By doing so, they build up the Church so that it will continue to minister to all for generations to come.

During his apostolic visit to Bangui in the Central African Republic in 2015, Pope Francis visited the city's pediatric hospital with a donation of medicines and a promise that he would not forget the country's children. With contributions raised to support Peter's Pence, the Holy Father kept that promise to the children of Bangui

by founding a new facility in 2017. The existing hospital was renovated, and a new facility specifically for malnourished children was constructed. In a March 2019 message, Pope Francis described the hospital as "a concrete sign of mercy" originating with his 2015 visit.

A Tradition of Support for the Holy Father

Support for such papal efforts has its roots in the scriptural message to take care of the poor and is an expression of unity with the Holy Father. Peter's Pence expresses this unity in two ways: through the ongoing activities of the Holy See and through the charitable works of the Holy Father on behalf of those most in need.

La participación concreta, incluyendo la económica, en las necesidades de la comunidad eclesial universal, ha tomado diferentes formas a lo largo de la historia. Estas colectas y donaciones por los fieles ya sea en forma individual, o por las iglesias locales en pleno, nos conciencian y nos llaman a todos los bautizados a sostener materialmente la labor de evangelización y, al mismo tiempo, a ayudar a los pobres en toda forma posible. Al hacerlo, ayudamos a construir la Iglesia para que pueda continuar haciendo su ministerio con todas las futuras generaciones.

En el 2015, durante su visita apostólica a Bangui, en la República Centroafricana, el papa Francisco visitó el hospital pediátrico de la ciudad, donando medicamentos y con la promesa de que no se olvidaría de los niños de ese país. Gracias a las contribuciones recaudadas en la Colecta Peter's Pence, el Santo Padre mantuvo su promesa a los niños de Bangui, fundando un nuevo local en el 2017. Se renovó el antiguo hospital y se construyó un local nuevo específicamente para los niños que sufren

Everyone must use main entrance and follow the instructions of the ushers. Please be patient. The side doors are ONLY emergency exits. They are marked by green crosses. People who live in the same home may sit together. Ushers will greet each person and show them to their seat.

Please limit private prayer after mass to no longer than 5 minutes so our volunteers can properly disinfect the church. The chapel and cry room will remain closed. There will be a collection basket at the entrance. No basket will be passed around and there will be no basket bearers. Hand sanitizer dispensers are in the Narthex as you enter and leave. No holding hands at Our Father and no contact peace. Ushers will direct section by section in a single line at three communion spots. Communion is **ONLY** distributed on the hand, not the tongue, for the time being at Incarnation. Please respect other's space in communion line with proper distance.

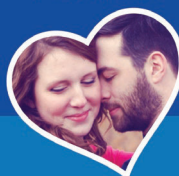
