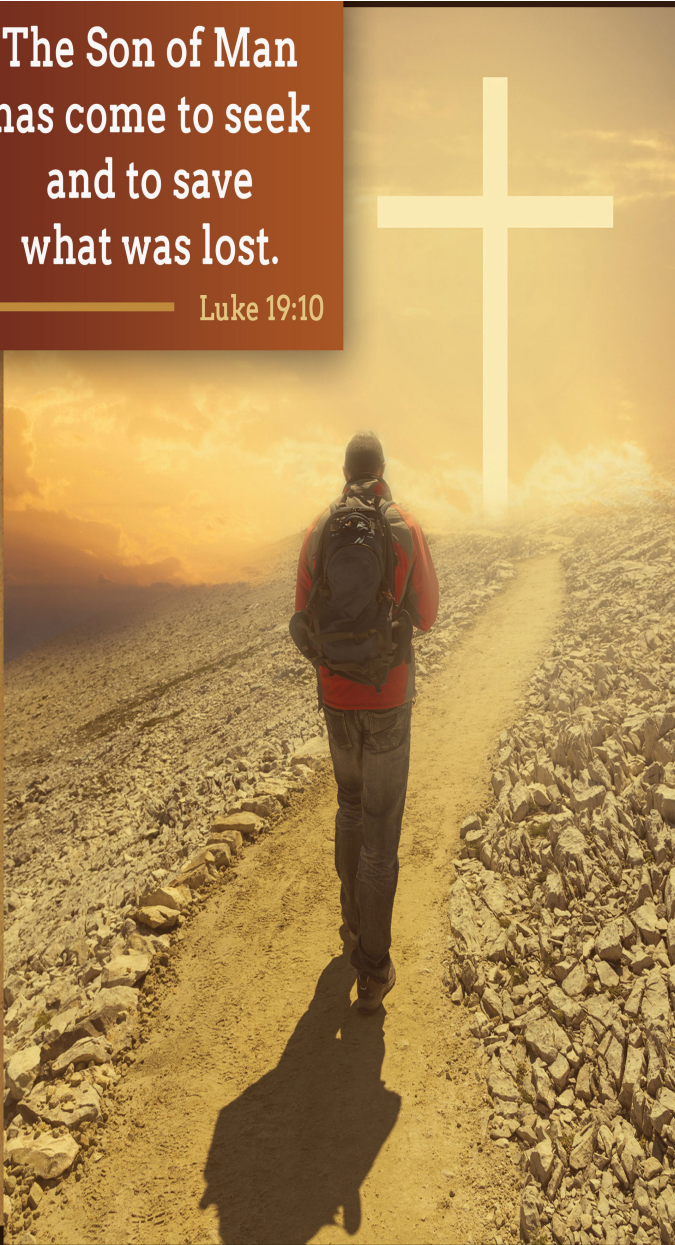

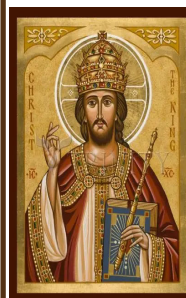

VOTE NO on PROPOSITION 1 on November 8, 2022

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. 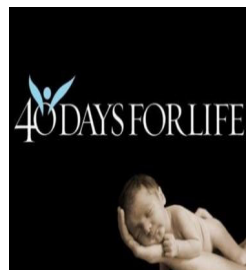
