Sister Margaret Mary Meyer, OP (formerly Sister M. Alacoque), a Dominican Sister of Caldwell for 68 years, was a woman of deep passions, profound convictions, and a faithful preacher of the Word in the traditional classroom, as a Director of Religious Education, and as a beloved member of her large family of more than 150 relatives. She instilled spiritual values and the love of God into the hearts and minds of countless children, from the East to the West Coast of the United States and even to the Bahamas. Before fully retiring, she spent several years in community service sharing her secretarial skills.

Upon retirement to Saint Catherine of Siena Convent and Healthcare Center in Caldwell, NJ, Sister Margaret Mary enjoyed the peace and solitude of her room where she had everything she needed, including a television to participate in the daily Mass and prayers, to watch her favorite game shows, and to enjoy following and rooting for her favorite sports team, the Mets! She also loved listening to music, writing notes, and completing word-find puzzles. She was a great hostess and continually shared what small or large treasures she had with others, including Oreos, holiday candies, and other treats.

Sister Margaret Mary's family knew her as the youngest and last of ten siblings. She grew up in a home bustling with conversation and activity, full of music, laughter, faith, and love. Sister Margaret Mary was a storyteller at heart and loved words, puzzles, puns, and being sociable. She had an infectious smile and a laugh that was

contagious. She doted on her nieces, nephews, grandnieces, and grandnephews and helped all experience joy and the challenge of living out the Gospel in their lives.

She enjoyed listening to classical music, liturgical music from the St. Louis Jesuits and Weston Priory, and classic American songs. One of the last songs she sang was on the phone with her niece a few weeks before she died: "*Take Me Out to the Ballgame.*"
