

From the Desk of Fr. Joseph Sevcik

Today we celebrate the awe-inspiring Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus is truly, really, substantially present in the Holy Eucharist. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, relying on the promise of Christ himself, at Mass the bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of our Lord. This is most appropriately termed transubstantiation. Though the appearance remains the same, the substantial identity (what it is/the underlying reality) has changed.


One of my increasing influences is Fr. Matthias Joseph Scheeben (1835-1888). He is one of the truly great and holy minds of his day. In a section on the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, in his book *The Mysteries of Christianity*, he writes "Every Christian looks up to the Eucharist as the miracle of an unspeakable, inconceivable love of God for us human beings, the love of God who desires to unite Himself to us in the closest possible manner" (479). The Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist is an astounding testament of God's love for us.

As I have preached, our hope is often far too short of the destiny and relationship to which God calls us. God desires not just to forgive us of sin, or assist us with low levels of grace, but has made us His adopted sons and daughters that we might share communion of life with him. Scheeben reflects on the gift of the Eucharist, "Why this stupendous, substantial union of the new Adam with man, if He wishes to do no more than offer satisfaction for our sins, or merit God's assistance for us, and does not intend, as supernatural progenitor of the race, to recharge our nature with divine energy, and to be for it the seed of a life that is not only humanly good and just, but divinely holy and blessed?" (479-80). Consider that! God gives the Eucharist to us to recharge our nature with divine energy. God wants us to share in his divine life

At Mass, when the drop of water is poured into the chalice, the deacon or the priest prays this very hope: By the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity. We pray each Mass that we might share in the divinity of Christ. What are the full implications of this prayer? The Son took on flesh to assume human nature to his divine person, and in the Ascension revealed to us the glory he wishes to share with us in the presence of the Father. The Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist is an infinitely great gift with which we are blessed. What more could we ask of God? Lord, you have made us for yourself, as we receive Holy Communion, with our Amen, may we receive you fully into our inmost being, to be filled with your glorious divine presence.
