WHAT DO I DO IN AN HOUR OF ADORATION?

There are several methods of meditation and all are good, but St. Julian Eymard suggests one which is truly Eucharistic since it is taken from the four ends of the Eucharistic Sacrifice. The four great acts of adoration, thanksgiving, reparation and petition comprise our entire duty towards God, the whole of Christian Life.

Eucharistic Adoration has for its object the Divine Person of Our Lord Jesus Christ present in the Most Blessed Sacrament. In this Sacrament he lives, he wishes us to speak to him and he will speak to us.

Now we must bear in mind that adoration is a dialogue. The adorer must speak to our Lord, and listen to him.
