Happy Epiphany! In the early centuries of our Church, the two biggest celebration days of the entire year were Easter and today's solemnity of Epiphany. During some centuries, these were the only two days on which adults received the sacraments of initiation, so each of these two liturgical peaks was preceded by a season of preparation and penance. Lent for Easter, and Advent for Epiphany. Originally, Epiphany commemorated four events in the life of Jesus: his birth; the coming of the Magi; his baptism by John; and his first miracle, changing water into wine at Cana. By the year 451, Christmas had been separated out and placed twelve days before Epiphany which was always on January 6.

In our own lifetime, the Church has further separated out the Baptism of the Lord to a separate feast and dropped any remembrance liturgically of the miracle at Cana. Further, Epiphany was moved in the US from January 6 to a Sunday. The Orthodox Catholic Churches still celebrate all four events together, which explains why their Christmas is a different date from the Latin Church.

So today, our emphasis is what the Gospel calls "Astrologers from the east". In medieval Christianity, these astrologers came to be depicted as three men (probably from the three gifts listed) and sometimes were called wise men or kings. They were even given names: Casper, Melchior and Balthasar. And they were usually pictured as being one of each of the three races known at that time - black,

brown, and white.

The core message of the Epiphany Feast today is that God has and is being revealed, and that God desires the salvation of all peoples of every race and nation. So, we celebrate today. God's self-revelation. to everyone and all creation. God's self-gift; God self-unveiling; God's communication with the world. This revelation is not just something over and done in the past, but is an ongoing outpouring of God's creative love into the entire world. Catholics believe that God continues to be revealed to us through the Holy Spirit active in the whole church. ordained and lav alike. We also believe that Jesus left us a living Church, ever guided by his spirit.

Epiphany also reminds us that God desires the salvation of all, not just the Jews or any other specific people or race or color. We might ask: is it possible to be saved, even without knowing Jesus? Yes. The Bishops said at Vatican Council II:

Those who through no fault of their own do not know the Gospel of Jesus or his Church, but who nonetheless, seek God with a sincere heart, and moved by grace, try in their actions to do his will, as they know it through the dicates of the conscience - those too may achieve eternal salvation.

So it is up to you and me to be revealers of Jesus to others. Our lives and our words must start leading others to Jesus, so that his Spirit can reveal his full self to them. And that coming to know him, they may pay him home with their most precious gifts and talents.

Guide us to the Perfect Light!

This ending to the Epiphany hymn, "We Three Kings," gives us an invitation to stay on the road with Jesus to guide us to that place we all long to be. As Christmas is not just a day, but a season, the Christmas season ends on Monday, January 9 with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

A somewhat forgotten action in the Church is blessing the doorposts of our homes on the Epiphany. I encourage you to take this prayer and practice this week of the Epiphany!

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling place among us. It is Christ who enlightens our hearts and homes with his love. May all who enter this home find Christ's light and love.

Read Luke 19:1-9

The intercessions are then said:

Leader: The Son of God made his home among us. With thanks and praise let us call upon him.

R/. Stay with us, Lord.

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ. with Mary and Joseph you formed the Holy Family: remain in our home, that we may know you as our guest and honor you as our Head.

We pray:

R/. Stay with us, Lord.

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ, you had no place to lay your head, but in the spirit of poverty accepted the hospitality of your friends: grant that through our help the homeless may obtain proper housing.

We pray:

R/. Stay with us, Lord.

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ, the three kings presented their gifts to you in praise and adoration: grant that those living in this house may use their talents and abilities to your greater glory.

We pray:

R/. Stay with us, Lord.

After the intercessions the leader invites all present to say the Lord's Prayer.

The leader says the prayer of blessing with hands ioined:

Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star.

Bless this house and all who inhabit it.

Fill them (us) with the light

of Christ, that their (our) concern for others may reflect your love.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

R/. Amen.

The leader concludes the rite by signing himself or herself with the sign of the cross and saying:

May Christ Jesus dwell with us, keep us from all harm, and make us one in mind and heart, now and forever.

R/. Amen




