





Registration ~ Are you new to the area or new to the Catholic Community of St. James? If yes, registration is simple. You may register on our website www.stjamesonline.org or call our Parish Office ext.104. Also, we receive many requests for testimonial letters, sponsorship forms for the Sacraments, letters of recommendation or character references. In order to accommodate you, you must be a registered and active parishioner for 6 months. Please contact the Parish Office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104. For those who have reached the age of 22 and work full time, please register as an individual.

Baptisms ~ Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday of the month at 1:15pm. Parents are required to attend a pre-baptism session first. Please call the parish office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104 for more information. After the baptism class, and when Godparents' sponsor certificates are provided, you may schedule a baptism, please call 732-634-0500 ext.104.

Qualifications for Godparents and Confirmation Sponsors ~ Must be at least 14 years of age, having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

Must be an active Catholic: someone who is registered in a Catholic parish, attends Mass, contributes to the support of the church, in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with church teaching. We can only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

These requirements are the <u>universal law</u> of the Church, and are not determined by the individual parish.

Marriages ~ Ideally, registered parishioners of St. James are welcome to make arrangements at least one year in advance. Please contact Maria at the Parish Office ext. 104, immediately after your engagement to schedule an appointment to speak with a priest or deacon in order to secure a date. The date with the church must be confirmed before making other social plans. Beginning April 2021 we will have weddings on Sunday at 3:00pm.

To Become a Roman Catholic....

R.C.I.A. ~ The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is the process by which we prepare non-Catholics who are interested in becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church, and Catholics who wish to complete their initiation sacraments. For information please call Deacon Bill Lange at the Parish Office, ext. 109.

Ministry To The Sick And Dying ~ We minister to those who are ill, in local hospitals or homebound, especially to those in hospice care. Please call 732-634-0500 and press 1. Anointing of the infirmed is an opportunity to pray for healing. If you are going for surgery or a test ask the priest after Mass or call the Parish Office.

Dear Family and Friends in Jesus Christ...,

Hallelujah... He is risen! Let us rejoice and be glad Hallelujah... In a conversation with one of the parishioners he said to me "I am not an Easter guy but I am a Christmas Guy" I asked him what does that mean? I said if it was not for Jesus' suffering death and resurrection Christmas would have no meaning. Without Easter, Jesus is just another man who caused too much trouble and got on a few too many people's nerves, and paid for it with His life. He was a little upset with me.

Easter puts the cross in perspective and reveals it for what it is. The cross was not foolishness, it is the most profound encounter with God's love humanity has ever experienced. It was not a result of a prophet whose miscalculations led to His death but was an act of redemption with eternal significance. Easter reveals that Jesus was not just another prophet put to death for speaking out against the wrong people, He is the Messiah, the savior of the world.

Without Easter, Jesus was still a profound moral teacher, a healer, an exorcist, and a prophet. But ultimately, He was still a foolish man who should have known enough to avoid such a gruesome and untimely end. But through the Resurrection, we are enabled to see the truth for what it is. Christ didn't come to reveal our need for a better system of ethics, He came to reveal our total dependence on God. Christ didn't die foolishly, He died to reveal God's boundless love for all creation (which includes you and me). Christ's death reveals the world's weakness and God's strength. The Resurrection makes known to us an entirely new understanding of reality in which our perceptions of foolishness and wisdom are set aright. It is a reality that calls us not to see through the eyes of the world, but through the eyes of God.

Easter brings great meaning to our life and fills it with Joy. Easter teaches us that our suffering and miseries have meaning. If the brutal Crucifixion of Jesus, the Son of God, can turn out to be the greatest event in all of human history, then your personal suffering, your burden, or even your sin can very much become a source of great joy as long as you let God transform it into part of His Resurrection!

This is the meaning of Easter! Easter means that nothing can keep us from the joy that God wants to give us. Nothing can steal that joy away. Sure, at times we will struggle just as Jesus did in the Agony of the Garden and the Way of the Cross, but those sufferings will not win. The Resurrection won with Christ and it will win with us when we cling to Him. Jesus persevered and, in the end, rose victorious. This is Easter! I tell you today that this Easter Sunday is not an anniversary of that first Easter morning. Nor, is this Easter a memorial – a remembrance of that first Easter Sunday morning. Today is Easter. Today is the Day the Lord has made. Today, He is Risen. Pay attention dear friends to those present tense words Today is Easter – this is the Day, they need to be heard by us. We are not recalling what happened to Jesus, nor the events of the first Easter. We are not spectators watching the reactions of the three disciples - Mary Magdalene, Peter, and John. Rather, this Easter Sunday is our sharing in the triumph and victory of God. As the Jesuit poet Gerard Manley Hopkins wrote, "Let Him Easter in us." Let that victory and triumph touch our lives. Christ, our Hope is Risen Alleluia. Let Him Easter in us. Let Easter bring new life to all of us despite whatever catastrophe we may face in the world or our personal situations. Let Him Easter in Us. Let this Easter celebration break open our tombs of fear, sin, worries, difficulties, problems, and fill us with Hope – with life. Let Christ Easter in YOU TODAY.




