

Registration ~ Are you new to the area or new to the Catholic Community of St. James? If yes, registration is simple. You may register on our website www.stjamesonline.org or call our Parish Office ext.104. Also, we receive many requests for testimonial letters, sponsorship forms for the Sacraments, letters of recommendation or character references. In order to accommodate you, you must be a registered and active parishioner for 6 months. Please contact the Parish Office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104. For those who have reached the age of 22 and work full time, please register as an individual.

Baptisms ~ Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday of the month at 1:15pm. Parents are required to attend a pre-baptism session first. Please call the parish office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104 for more information. After the baptism class, and when Godparents' sponsor certificates are provided, you may schedule a baptism, please call 732-634-0500 ext.104.

Qualifications for Godparents and Confirmation Sponsors ~ Must be at least 14 years of age, having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

Must be an active Catholic: someone who is registered in a Catholic parish, attends Mass, contributes to the support of the church, in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with church teaching. We can only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

These requirements are the <u>universal law</u> of the Church, and are not determined by the individual parish.

Marriages ~ Ideally, registered parishioners of St. James are welcome to make arrangements at least one year in advance. Please contact Maria at the Parish Office ext. 104, immediately after your engagement to schedule an appointment to speak with a priest or deacon in order to secure a date. The date with the church must be confirmed before making other social plans. Beginning April 2021 we will have weddings on Sunday at 3:00pm.

To Become a Roman Catholic....

R.C.I.A. ~ The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is the process by which we prepare non-Catholics who are interested in becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church, and Catholics who wish to complete their initiation sacraments. For information please call Deacon Bill Lange at the Parish Office, ext. 109.

Ministry To The Sick And Dying ~ We minister to those who are ill, in local hospitals or homebound, especially to those in hospice care. Please call 732-634-0500 and press 1. Anointing of the infirmed is an opportunity to pray for healing. If you are going for surgery or a test ask the priest after Mass or call the Parish Office.

Dear Family and Friends in Jesus Christ...,

Happy Father's Day to all fathers, grandfathers, and stepfathers. Five weeks ago, we observed Mother's Day and offered Mass for our mothers. Today, on this Father's Day, we are doing the same – offering our dads, living or dead, on the altar of God during this Holy Mass and invoking our Heavenly Father's blessings on them. Today we celebrate, congratulate, and pray for the men who continue to reflect the Divine qualities of



fatherhood as they lovingly establish, nourish, and maintain their families. Fathers are a blessing, and we thank them for blessing us with lives of dedication, endurance, and love.

Children who are raised with fathers present in the family have much lower rates of delinquency, drug and alcohol use, teen pregnancy, and so on than those with absent fathers. The father's presence is also a significant positive factor in the child receiving a college education, finding a satisfying job, and making a lasting marriage. A girl's choice of partner and satisfaction in marriage is often directly related to the relationship she has had with her father.

St. Therese of Lisieux and St. Teresa of Avila have their own stories about the influence their fathers had on their lives as role models. The Little Flower used to ask an innocent question to her first-grader classmates: "Have you ever seen a saint praying?" She would add: "If you haven't, come to my house in the evening. You will see my dad on his knees in his room with outstretched arms, praying for us, his children, every day." She states in one of her letters from the convent: "I have never seen or heard or experienced anything displeasing to Jesus in my family." In the final year of her high school studies, St. Teresa of Avila was sent by her father (against her will), to a boarding house conducted by nuns. Her father took action at the moment he discovered bad books and yellow magazines hidden in her box. These had been supplied to Teresa by her spoiled friend and classmate, Beatrice. St. Teresa later wrote as the Mother Superior: "But for that daring and timely action of my father, I would have ended up in the streets, as a notorious woman." Father's Day challenges Christian Fathers to be role models to their children.

A favorite gift for Father's Day is the cap embroidered with the words "World's Greatest Dad." You may see them on the heads of proud fathers everywhere. There is one dad, however, who does not always get a lot of honor on Father's Day. That is the "World's Greatest Dad," **OUR HEAVENLY FATHER** (Rom. 8:15, Gal. 4:6). He is our Abba, Daddy, actively involved in all areas of our lives. It is He on Whom we lean in times of pain and hurt; it is He on Whom we call in times of need; it is He Who provides for us in all ways — practical, emotional, and spiritual. He wants us to think of Him as "Dad." This being so, let us take this Father's Day to honor Him, the **REAL** "World's Greatest Dad." Many of us pray the "Our Father" day after day, without paying attention to, or experiencing, the love and providence of our Heavenly Father. Let us pray the Our Father during this Holy Mass realizing the meaning of each clause and experiencing the love of our Heavenly Father for us. May all earthly fathers draw strength from their Heavenly Father! On this Father's Day, please don't forget to pray for us your spiritual Fathers — men who are called to be Fathers of an immensely large parish family through the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

The gospel this Sunday teaches us how can we fight fear with faith. Jesus' sleeping presence on the storm-tossed sea reveals the sleeping faith of His disciples. They feared for their lives even though their Lord and Master was with them in the boat. They were asleep to Christ while He was present to them in their hour of need. The Lord Jesus is ever-present to us. And in our time of testing, He asks the same question: Why are you afraid? Have you no faith? Do you recognize the Lord's presence with you, especially when you meet the storms of adversity, sorrow, and temptation? Whenever we encounter trouble, the Lord is there with the same reassuring message: "It is I, do not be afraid."

What are the characteristics of faith and how can we grow in it? Faith is an entirely free gift that God makes to us. Believing is only possible by the grace and the help of the Holy Spirit, who moves the heart and who opens the eyes of the mind to understand and accept the truth which God has revealed to us. Faith enables us to relate to God rightly and confidently, with trust and reliance, by believing and adhering to his word, because He is utterly reliable and trustworthy. If we want to live, grow, and persevere in faith, then it must be nourished with the word of God.

Fear does not need to cripple us from taking the right action or rob us of our trust and reliance on God. Courage working with faith enables us to embrace God's word of truth and love with confidence and to act on it with firm hope in God's promises. The love of God strengthens us in our faith and trust in Him and enables us to act with justice and kindness towards our neighbor even in the face of opposition or harm. Do you allow the love of Christ to rule in your heart and mind, and to move your will to choose what is good in accordance with His will?

Let us pray: "Lord Jesus, increase my faith in your redeeming love and power that I may always recognize your abiding presence with me. And give me the courage to do your will in all circumstances."

Dear Parishioners,

We are experiencing some issues with our Air Conditioning System. We turned it on and as many of you experienced a couple of weeks ago the church is not cooling. There are many issues affecting the system which includes the chiller, low refrigerant, and among other things a faulty electronic metering valve. Replacing the electronic metering valve is a big process and very expensive.

We are being told this valve replacement alone will cost the Parish \$6,000.00 plus all the other maintenance costs totaling over \$10,000. We have a second collection for the Air Conditioning scheduled for **July 24 & July 25**, please consider us, as your means allow. I am hopeful that once the repairs are made we will have our system up and running to capacity for the summer. Please pray that nothing else breaks.
