

You may register on our website www.stjamesonline.org or call our Parish Office ext.104. Also, we receive many requests for testimonial letters, sponsorship forms for the Sacraments, letters of recommendation or character references. In order to accommodate you, you must be a registered and active parishioner for 6 months. Please contact the Parish Office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104. For those who have reached the age of 22 and work full time, please register as an individual.

Baptisms ~ Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday of the month at 1:15pm. Parents are required to attend a pre-baptism session first. Please call the parish office at 732-634-0500 ext. 104 for more information. If you would like to request a Baptism Class or Baptism in Spanish, please call the parish office 732-634-0500 ext. 104. After the baptism class, and when Godparents' sponsor certificates are provided, you may schedule a baptism, please call 732-634-0500 ext.104.

Qualifications for Godparents and Confirmation Sponsors ~ Must be at least 14 years of age, having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

Must be an active Catholic: someone who is registered in a Catholic parish, attends Mass, contributes to the support of the church, in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with church teaching. We can only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

These requirements are the <u>universal law</u> of the Church, and are not determined by the individual parish.

Marriages ~ Ideally, registered parishioners of St. James are welcome to make arrangements at least one year in advance. Please contact Maria at the Parish Office ext. 104, immediately after your engagement to schedule an appointment to speak with a priest or deacon in order to secure a date. The date with the church must be confirmed before making other social plans. Wedding times - Friday 5:00pm - Saturday 11:30am, 1:30 & 3:30pm. Sunday 3:00pm.

To Become a Roman Catholic....

R.C.I.A. ~ The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is the process by which we prepare non-Catholics who are interested in becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church, and Catholics who wish to complete their initiation sacraments. Dear Family and Friends in Jesus Christ...,

The First Reading and the Gospel are teaching us about the sacredness of the Sacrament of Marriage and family life. I asked some of my friends here if they have something to say about married life that will help me preach today. One man said "I better not say anything. I am a married man. One wife said, "It depends on the day whether I am for it or against it. One widow said, enjoy it while you can".



Giving up married life was one of the issues that I had to deal with before I got ordained as a priest. And it is the major reason most people do not go into religious life or enter into priesthood.

When Jesus was asked if it is lawful for a man to divorce his wife, the Jews knew the answer because divorce was permitted in Jewish Law. But Jesus surprised them. He referred to the original intention of God when they created human beings. He affirmed the exclusive and permanent character of Marriage. He said: For this reason, a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined man must not separate."

When Pope Francis visited the US on September 19 through the 27, 2015 the whole country was very excited. On that Sunday he addressed the World Meeting of Families. I think this is the best time to rewind all that he tried to teach us about marriage and family life. Pope Francis spoke after intense and often heartrending testimonies of several families from around the globe. Families from as far as Nigeria, Australia, Jordan, Argentina, and Ukraine shared their respective stories with the Pope, touching on themes that involved war, disability, economic uncertainty, discrimination, and the death of children.

The Pope said a little boy once asked him a question. And he said, "Kids can sometimes ask very serious questions." The boy asked, "What was God doing before he created the world?" The Pope answered, "God was loving. God's love is so overflowing that it could not be egotistic, it had to be poured out of Him," the Pope said, "And He created the universe." The creation is the overflow of God's love. Then the Pope asked, "Do you know what is the most beautiful thing of all that God created?" "The most beautiful thing that God did, the Bible says, was the family," he said, "A society is strong, solid, and edified on beauty goodness, and truth with the presence of good families. Family is really family when it is able to open its arms and receive all with love and forgiveness."

"However, that love God gave almost was lost," he said. "In a little time, the first crime, the first instance of fratricide, the first instance of war, men and women, through the astuteness of the devil, have unfortunately learned to divide themselves."

"But God did not abandon them," the Pope stressed. "So great was His love that He began to walk with humanity, with His people until the right moment and He made the highest expression of love, His own Son." "And how did he send His son?" he asked. "Through a family." He said, "Families have difficulties. Families, quarrel. And sometimes plates can fly. Children bring headaches, and I won't even speak about mothers-in-law...In families, there are always difficulties, but those difficulties are overcome by love," he said. "Hatred is not capable of dealing with any difficulty...Only love is able to overcome them."

He reminded us of a truth that we all know and have to keep in mind all the time. "There is no perfect family. We have no perfect parents, we are not perfect, do not get married to a perfect person, neither do we have perfect children. We have complaints about each other. We are disappointed by one another. Therefore, there is no healthy marriage or healthy family without the exercise of forgiveness. Forgiveness is vital to our emotional health and spiritual survival. Without forgiveness, the family becomes a theater of conflict and a bastion of grievances. Without forgiveness the family becomes sick. Forgiveness is the sterilization of the soul, cleansing the mind, and the liberation of the heart. Anyone who does not forgive has no peace of soul and communion with God. Pain is a poison that intoxicates and kills. Maintaining a wound of the heart is a self-destructive action. It is autophagy. He who does not forgive sickens physically, emotionally, and spiritually. That is why the family must be a place of life and not of death; an enclave of cure not of disease; a stage of forgiveness and not of guilt. Forgiveness brings joy where sorrow produced pain; and healing, where pain caused disease."

In the end, he prayed for all the families and asked for the intercession of our Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph. He said it in prayer that we build up the bond and intimacy. It is in prayer that we learn to forgive and in prayer that we learn to accept each other as they are. He reminded us that there shouldn't be a day that we spent without praying together as a family.

The Twelfth in a Series

"The Vocation and Mission of the Lay Faithful in the Church and in the World"

In CHRISTIFIDELES LAICI, the pope addresses three main social problems of our times using the image of the vineyard found in the Gospel (Mt 20:1-16). The first, addressed in "The Eleventh in a Series," was secularism that cuts "the religious roots that are in people's hearts" and if people retain anything of God it is simply "without meaning in their lives" (#4.1).

The second trend in the modern world is the degradation of the human person and the violation of his or her rights. There are powerful forces at work as in inhumane systems, scientific technocracy or intrusion of mass media that those who are stronger often use to manipulate and enslave. The pope insists "the sacredness of the human person cannot be obliterated" (#5.4). People are more conscious that the person is a free and responsible "subject" and not an "object" to be used. There are also new forms of authentic humanism that sustain and foster human dignity.
