## Celebrating the Sacraments of the Catholic Church

**Baptisms:** Parents wishing to have their child baptized must be registered and active members for at least three months and are asked to make an appointment with the pastor one month in advance.

**Confirmation:** Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

**Marriage:** Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, to meet with him before setting a date or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor. (If either in the couple has been previously married, an annulment by the Church may be necessary)

**Confessions:** Please call the parish office and leave a message or email Father Ed to make an appointment for Confession. Check the bulletin for scheduled Confessions.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, even before a surgery, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

**Visits by Priest, Deacon, Parish Care Volunteers** In addition to Fr. Ed, Fr. Jeffrey, and Deacon Mike, we have trained volunteers who will visit and bring Communion to you or a loved one at home, in rehab or nursing home, or in the hospital. Please let us know if you or someone you know would like to have these visits! (And please make sure we know when you or a loved one are homebound or hospitalized!)

**Sacramental Emergencies** After business hours, if somebody is actively dying and needs the Sacrament of Anointing, please call the office at 419-634-2626 and hit 7 for sacramental emergencies. The call will be directed to Fr. Ed or his voicemail, and he will call you back right away.

## Advent Penance Service

**Time Change:** December 6 from 12:00 - 2:00 so that those who attend Mass can remain for confessions.

To begin with Exposition and Adoration Confessions will be heard by Fr. Ed and Fr. Jeffrey

Two of our Second Graders, who will be celebrating their First Reconciliation, will go first to have their Confessions heard by Fr. Ed.

## Confessions - Pandemic Protocol

We are using the Confessional for Confessions since the priest and the penitent are divided by a wall. Please be sure to use hand sanitizer before you enter the confessional and avoid touching any surfaces unnecessarily. You may ask to have the screen open or closed, as you prefer.

## How to go to Confession

- ✚ Priest gives a blessing or greeting.
- ✚ Make the Sign of the Cross and say,
- ✚ "Bless me, father, for I have sinned. It has been \_\_\_\_\_ (how long?) since my last confession."
- ✚ Confess all of your sins to the priest and then say, "I am sorry for these and all of my sins."
- ✚ The priest assigns a penance and offers advice to help you do better.
- ✚ Say an Act of Contrition\*
- ✚ The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.
- ✚ Do the penance that the priest has assigned.

*\* My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior, Jesus Christ, suffered and died for us. In His name, my God, have mercy.*

There will also be an Advent Penance Service at Immaculate Conception in Kenton on Monday, December 14 from 5:00 - 7:00 pm.
