A Win-Win Year-End Tax Strategy

Did you know that you can use your IRA to support your parish or other Catholic causes?

The IRA Charitable Rollover or Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows donors who are 70 ½ and older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. By transferring your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), donors avoid having to claim the allocation as gross income on their taxes. You may also prevent yourself from being bumped into a higher tax bracket, effectively lowering your tax bill. QCD transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation to qualify.

Don't forget that all transfers must be completed by December 31st to qualify as a 2021 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income.

Rose Candle and Rose Vestments During Advent we await the celebration of Christ's birth and His coming again at the end of time. Over these four weeks, we prepare our hearts for Christmas in penitential reflection. But in the middle of the season, Gaudete Sunday calls us to rejoice in hope! Gaudete (pronounced in three syllables: Gow-day-tay) means "rejoice" in Latin. The Catholic Church uses the color rose to indicate a joyful feast day or holiday.

Lord Jesus, Master of both the light and the darkness, send your Holy Spirit upon our preparations for Christmas.
