

We are required to have annual PSR Registration forms turned in *and* we will be ordering the textbooks in the next two weeks! Grandparents are welcome, with parent/guardian permission and signature to assume the responsibility for getting grandchildren registered and to classes. Volunteers in the PSR are a valuable resource for our parish and the Church as a whole. If you have been thinking about how you can be involved, please prayerfully consider this ministry! We would like to have a full-time assistant in the preschool's Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (one Sunday a month during the Whole Family Session) plus others to serve as substitutes and assistants in other grades. You may contact Ann Johnson for information about helping! Anyone who works with children must consent to a formal application, PSR Coordinator and Pastor interview, fingerprinting and background check, and attend a Protecting God's Children Training. *If you have had Virtus PGC* and background check within the last year, we may be able to have your credentials transferred here.
