**Saint Anthony Mary Claret – Feast Day Oct 24**

Born in Spain in 1807, young Antonio learned his father's trade of weaving, as well as printing and Latin, all before studying for the priesthood. Ordained at 28, he went on to become one of Spain's most popular preachers. At 42, he founded a religious institute of missionaries known popularly as the Claretians.

Appointed to head the much-neglected Archdiocese of Santiago, Cuba. He began its reform by ceaselessly preaching and hearing confession. He suffered bitter opposition for preaching against unmarried persons living together and giving instructions to black slaves. When a hired assassin slashed his face and wrist, Anthony responded by getting the would-be assassin death's sentence commuted to a prison term.

Anthony went on to found the Religious Publishing House and write or publish 200 books and pamphlets.

Saint Anthony Mary Claret is the patron saint of weavers.
