Bernard was born into a wealthy and pious family but spent a wild and dissolute youth. He had time to reflect and realized he was headed in the wrong direction. Bernard renewed his life in the Church and then joined the Dominicans in Catania in 1452. He was a gifted preacher, he preferred to spend his time in the confessional and working as a spiritual director. He had the gift of prophecy and used it to warn people to change their lives. Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at East.

Prayer – Lent is essentially an act of prayer spread out over 40 days. As we pray, we go on a journey, one that hopefully brings us closer to Christ and leaves us changed by the encounter with him.

Fasting – Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Fasting is actually a form of penance, which helps us turn away from sin and toward Christ.

Almsgiving – The giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts – not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents.

The more serious side of Lenten discipline is that it's about more than self-control – it's about finding aspects of yourself that are less than Christ-like and letting them die. The suffering and death of Christ are foremost on our minds during lent, and we join in these mysteries by suffering, dying with Christ and being resurrected in a purified form.

Giving of ourselves in the midst of our suffering and self-denial brings us closer to love like Christ, who suffered and poured himself out unconditionally on the Cross for all of us. Lent is a journey through the desert to the foot of the Cross on Good Friday, as we seek him out, ask his help, join in his suffering, and learn to love like him.
