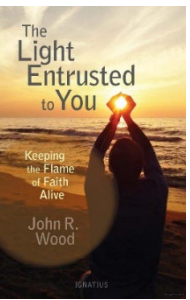
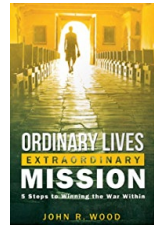

### Prayer, Fasting & Almsgiving

The first pillar of Lent is prayer. Lent is a time of spiritual renewal, and during Lent we put special time aside to be prayerful and reflective. There are many ways to pray, or communicate with God, but we are encouraged to find a way of connecting with God that feels right for you.

Here are ideas to reconnect with God through prayers:

- Experiment with a new form or way of praying (walking a labyrinth, Lectio Divina, meditation)
- For one week, set your alarm 10 minutes early and spend that time in prayer
- For one week, do an examination of conscience before you go to bed, reviewing your day.
- Set up an intentional space for prayer
- Participate in the Stations of the Cross, or pray the rosary each week
- Celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation this Lent
