**Country Store** - We will be having our usual Country Store, Drop off good clean household items at the St. Anthony Center.

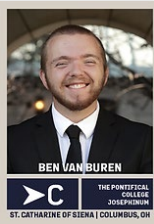
**Theme Baskets** must be completely made up and covered with all items listed and attached.
