Special Election

As we approach the special election on August 8th, 2023, there have been some questions circulating regarding our stance on Issue 1. Bishop Earl K. Fernandes gives the below direction:

Bishop Earl K. Fernandes advises that it is permissible to encourage parishioners to vote, "YES" on Issue 1, at the special election on August 8th, 2023. Issue 1 asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." This would be the quickest way to defeat the abortion amendment working its way toward the polls in November.

World Youth Day 2023

The international World Youth Day celebration takes place every 2-3 years, typically in the summer months and on a major scale. The next WYD will take place from August 1-6, 2023 in Lisbon, Portugal with millions of people and the Holy Father. WYD was initiated by Pope John Paul II in 1985. This will be the 37th World Youth Day. The theme for this year is "Mary rose up and went with haste" (Luke 1:39), which opens the account of the Visitation, when Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth following the angel's announcement to the Blessed Mother that she would be the mother of the Son of God. Let us pray for the hearts and souls of all those pilgrimaging to Lisbon to worship with the Holy Father.

Cake Booth. Many cakes & pies will be needed at the festival. Remember ingredient items must be listed.


