From the Pastor

The Vatican will again offer a plenary indulgence to mark the third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on July 23. The indulgence can be received by all Catholics who, "motivated by the true spirit of penance and charity," watch the Pope's July 23 Mass, or attend a Grandparents' Day celebration, or who visit the elderly, sick or disabled, including by phone. Next weekend, the 3 Sunday Masses will be considered celebrations of Grandparents' Day at Nativity as I will give a blessing at the end of each Mass. The day will be marked this year on July 23, the Sunday before the Feast of Saints Anne and Joachim, the grandparents of Jesus. The plenary indulgence for Grandparents' Day 2023 was granted by a July 5 decree from Cardinal Piacenza, the head of the Apostolic Penitentiary, a tribunal of the Apostolic See with jurisdiction over indulgences and the absolution of the gravest sins. An indulgence is defined by the Catechism of the Catholic Church as "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven." The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence require the individual to be in a state of grace, have complete detachment from sin, and pray for the pope's intentions. The person must also sacramentally confess their sins and receive Communion, up to about 20 days before or after the prayers for the indulgence. Pope Francis, who often speaks about the dignity of the elderly and the importance of grandparents in passing on the faith, established the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021. - Fr. Andy

"I came to the parish Mission in February and I could barely walk. My pain level was at a 6/10 and I had braces on my legs. After listening to the talk I came up to receive the Holy Spirit. I rested in the Spirit and I was healed to the point that I could run up and down the aisles! I no longer had any pain, and I didn't have to wear the leg braces anymore. I knew that there was something in my family's past that required me to do some deliverance prayers, so I scheduled a time a couple of months later and while I did those prayers with Fr. Andy I experienced uncontrollable tears, pain in my chest and visions of dragons, but as soon as we completed the prayers, everything stopped and I felt free. I felt a true peace I had not felt before. Fast forward a few months later and I am still pain free, walking without any aids, and I still feel at peace. Before I did the deliverance prayers I always felt like there was something in the way with my relationship with Jesus. Since I have said the prayers I feel free, at peace, and that I am able to walk happily, with Jesus as my guide."
