"Coming into healing prayer I had shoulder pain, and received healing in my right shoulder. At that time I was scheduled for prostate surgery a couple of weeks after, so I also sought the Lord for a successful surgery and healing. The surgery was successful and I have tested cancer free going on two years. That seed of faith drew me back. I did not know what to expect, but my faith had grown since my previous experience. My personal testimony is being called to Reconciliation for the 4th time in my 44 years of Catholic life. As a Methodist convert I struggled with Reconciliation over the years, but the Holy Spirit pressed me to go and hand off my burdens in Reconciliation to Him. The fruit is Spiritual Healing rather than the physical touch I received last time."
