

In this corner of the bulletin we will relay witness stories anonymously as we receive them.

"I was having heart problems and I was going to have a heart catherization first thing the next morning, so I contacted Fr. Andy for the sacrament(s) of the sick. He came to visit me in the hospital late that evening and gave me the sacraments, he also shared the Litany of Forgiveness with me which I prayed on my own. A few days later I called him to ask him what specifically he prayed over me, and he said he didn't do anything but his usual, but I had to tell him what happened. I didn't realize it right away, but I usually have a lot of pain from arthritis in my neck and my right shoulder, and a calcium build-up on my hip with more pain from arthritis, and the medical staff was going to give me some shots but I realized, all of that pain is gone. It was debilitating pain too, all gone, praise be to God. Whether it was the anointing, the litany, or Fr. Andy's prayer, I'll never know, but I know God healed me!"
