From the Pastor

In the Church of the Nativity, the stained glass on the south side of the church represents Bethlehem on the night Jesus was born, while the three windows on the north represent the Triduum, starting with the Last Supper on the right, the Crucifixion in the middle, and the Resurrection on the left. Somewhat ironically, the Christmas tree gets setup right in front of the Resurrection window. It is mostly because we have a lot of space there, but it is somewhat appropriate because without the Resurrection, the Nativity of Jesus is just the birth of a random baby. The Resurrection is what makes Jesus' birth special, because in the Resurrection our salvation was won! That means that the Nativity of Jesus Christ was the birth of our Savior, and this is why we celebrate in such grand fashion. Even our tree points our hearts and mind upwards to God. Our God humbled Himself to share in our humanity that quiet night over 2,000 years ago, so we give thanks as we celebrate the birth of our savior, the one we put our trust in still today. - Fr.
