

Healing Corner

At Nativity each week there is an open opportunity to receive healing prayer beginning at 6pm on Wednesday, going until everyone has received prayer, look for instructions in the church. A session generally takes 10-15 minutes, but if a session needs to go longer, recipients are invited to contact Serena Freisinger at the office at (563) 582-1839 or via email at dbq057s4@dbqarch.org to schedule an appointment. In this corner of the bulletin we will relay witness stories anonymously as we receive them. "I've struggled with neuropathy in my two middle toes on my right foot for probably 4-5 years. Went to see a foot doctor/surgeon who basically said this would likely be a life-long condition...In the morning when I walked down our flight of stairs to our main floor, typically it hurts tremendously, and I found I was walking on my heel to avoid the contact. This was something I'd just grown to live with, often giving thanks to the Lord when experiencing the pain ("give thanks in all things"). During the healing service, [a priest] was going through a litany of maladies folks were struggling with. When he got to [health issues] below the knee I stood up. I think he prayed over us twice and no real change. My good brother in Christ was sitting next to me. He placed his hand on my knee, and I began to experience what almost felt like pain in my right shin. But the longer I stood the more "lit up" it became - knee to my ankle. The next morning, I was sitting in my hotel room in prayer and heard the Lord say, "Look down at your foot -I've healed you." It's now four days later and I've experienced no more pain (Glory to God!)."
