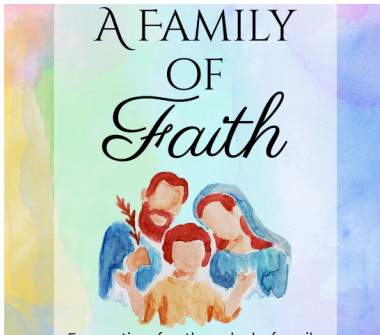

Sacramental Prep



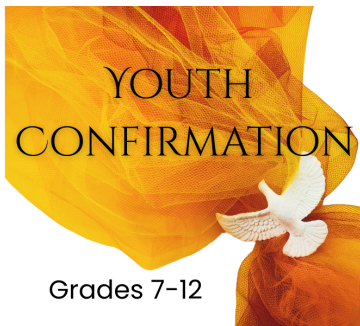
The Archdiocese of Seattle has a 2 year preparation process for our children to prepare for the sacraments of penance and First Communion. Children age 7, are ready to begin this journey so, when your child is in the First grade, they should enroll in our Family of Faith program if they are not in a Catholic School . This begins their preparation process. In their 2nd grade year, they should enroll in Family of Faith and take part in our Family-At Home preparation for the Sacrament.

Grades 7-12

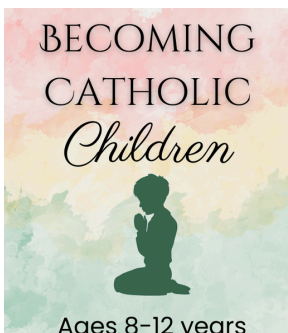
Confirmation is the sacrament of initiation in which a baptized person receives special gifts of the Holy Spirit and is strengthened in grace. Students in grades 7-12 are invited to prepare for this sacrament. We will be meeting on select Tuesday evenings, and monthly Sunday afternoons. Our first class will be October 7th.

Becoming Catholic - Children



Ages 8-12 years

OCIC stands for Order of Christian Initiation of Children. OCIC is the process whereby children ages 9 -13 may be initiated into and fully enter the Catholic Church. It is for non-Catholic children who have not completed their own sacraments of initiation. Children should register and attend Family of Faith classes, as well as attend select Wednesday evening sessions.
