Our parish is participating in a Spiritual Adoption Program until Christmas. We pray for the unborn, mothers, fathers. all preborn babies, especially those who may be vulnerable to abortion, for parents who are considering abortion and for those choosing to make an adoption plan. We will conclude our spiritual adoption by honoring the birth of our Lord and Savior by donating baby gifts to Heartbeats.

*"I had a dream!" The baby's brain has begun maturing - a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her eyelids are now sealed shut and will re-open at 7 months. Her taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her in an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month REMs (rapid eye movements) have been recorded, a sign of dreaming.*
