My Brothers and Sisters,

Tuesday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into heaven. ***This year, it is a Holy Day of obligation. Masses will be said at both 8:30 a.m. and 6:15 p.m.***

As we prepare to enter into the school year, please note the many activities for **faith formation** coming this Fall in this week's bulletin.

Our parish not only responded generously and met our diocesan assigned goal of \$86,000 for this year's Appeal, but has well exceeded it! To date, we have \$160,000 in pledges. That means our parish, thus far, has \$70,000 toward our designated projects including the east sidewalk, ramp, and drainage, as well as redoing the main parking lot. ***Thank you so much for responding so generously to these needed improvements!*** We are trying to complete these projects before school begins. I ask for your patience during this process of construction when we may not have full access to our parking lot. Please be careful when entering the Church and know some doors may be inaccessible. We will continue to inform you and give you updates along the way.

Some exciting news regarding the expansion of EdChoice which makes Catholic Schools more affordable and accessible to our families. The new state budget, which was signed, allows EdChoice scholarships for all families! Please contact our school for more information on how to submit the application and what it can mean for your family.

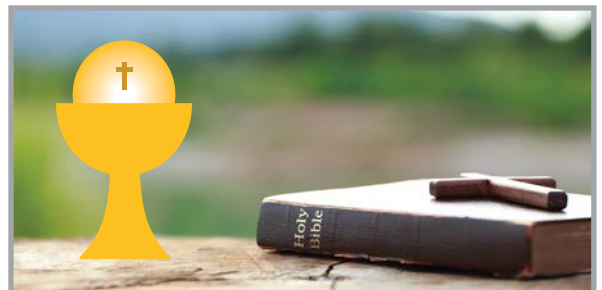

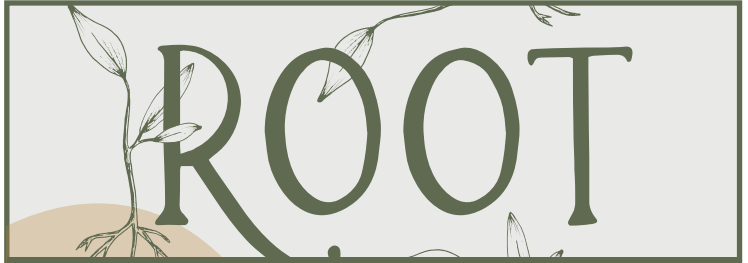
