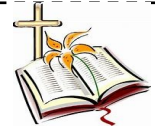

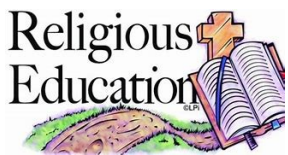

XXIV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Queridos hermanos, un gran motivo nos reúne nuevamente en la casa de Dios en este Vigésimo cuarto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario: la misericordia de Dios es infinita y aún con nuestros pecados, Dios nos perdona si nos arrepentimos.

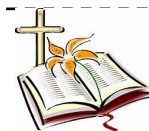
Hoy se da de nuevo una coincidencia de las tres lecturas en una dirección: el perdón de los pecados por la misericordia de Dios. Tanto Yahvé, que perdona a su pueblo por intercesión de Moisés, como Pablo, que se siente él personalmente objeto del perdón de Cristo, como las tres parábolas de Jesús en el evangelio, nos invitan hoy a considerar esa Buena Noticia del perdón y del amor de Dios.
