Sixth Sunday of Easter

"But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you." John 14:26

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that the Holy Spirit would remind them of all that he told them.

But Jesus had not addressed every matter that would arise. Twenty years later, in the scene at the center of the first reading, the apostles need to decide what to do about uncircumcised Gentiles who want to be baptized as Christians. Some said,

"Unless you are circumcised according to the Mosaic practice, you cannot be saved (Acts 15:1). But Paul and Barnabas dissented. So they returned to Jerusalem to meet with the apostles and elders. There, guided by the Holy Spirit about this question

Jesus never addressed, they decided a minimal number of Mosaic practices were necessary to follow and that circumcision was not one of them. Twenty centuries later, we hope to allow the Holy Spirit to guide church leaders as they debate contentious issues for which the best answer is uncertain.

Disciples of Jesus steward their vocations (marriage, single life, consecrated life, ecclesial lay ministry, or Holy Orders) by serving the Body of Christ through prayer, time, and finances, according to
