**JUBILEE PILGRIMS OF HOPE RETREAT**

All are welcome to attend the second Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope Retreat on Saturday, **June 28, 2025, at Saint Joseph's Church, Rawlins**, beginning at 9 am, and closing with Mass at 4:15 pm. The retreat focuses on hope for prisoners, rehabilitation, forgiveness, and abolition of the death penalty. This theme coincides with *Spes Non Confundit* (*Hope does not Disappoint*) paragraph 10. Bishop Steven will open the retreat by discussing hope and the sources of hope: Word of God, Holy Spirit, Paschal Mystery, and Saints of Hope. Participants will join in Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, and engage in the Spiritual Conversation and a Mercy Hour.

**Simultaneous translation into Spanish will be available, and lunch will be provided.**
