My dear brothers and sisters, hello! My name is Fr. Andrew Kinstetter. It is with great joy that I am finally here at St. Laurence O'Toole to begin ministering as pastor! Please pray for me as I transition fully into parish life here and become not just the "new guy in town" but truly the father that God calls me to be as pastor here at St. Laurence O'Toole. I am so excited to be here (and quite a bit nervous too!). This is my first time as pastor so there is a lot of learning to be done by me and I am doing my best to jump in with both feet. I wanted to take this opportunity to share about myself with you briefly (watch for a more in depth sharing later once I get settled in). I am a Wyoming native, I grew up on a ranch in NE Wyoming

with a wonderful family who instilled in me my Catholic faith. I am the middle child with two brothers (I'm sure you can imagine how active three boys were growing up together!). Initially out of high school I went to college in Rapid City, SD at the School of Mines/Technology to study Computer Science, but after three years began feeling unfulfilled in that career path as I began to feel more joy in ministering at the Cathedral parish in Rapid City. I realized that in order to be truly fulfilled interiorly I needed to respond to God's call in my life, which was to discern the priesthood. I entered seminary and finished my college degree (in Philosophy now, not Computer Science) at Conception Seminary College (a Benedictine Monastery in Missouri) and continued my Theology studies at St. John Vianney Theological Seminary in Denver, CO, after which I was ordained a priest at the Cathedral of St. Mary in Cheyenne in 2016. My first assignment was at St. Stephens Indian Mission just outside of Riverton where I ministered on to the Native Americans living there and then I was transferred to the Cathedral of St. Mary in Cheyenne, where I have been for the past three years. These past four years have been full of joys, challenges, highs and lows, all of which have continued to shape me into the man and priest I am today. Once you get to know me, you'll find that I am quite the geek and love to enjoy life. To say I'm a Star Wars fan is a bit of an understatement (I even host a Star Wars/Catholic podcast: [www.sqpn.com/starwars](http://www.sqpn.com/starwars)) and I'm a fan of most things in the technology world and science fiction/superhero worlds as well (I love to go to the movies...even though I'll have to wait until the pandemic is over to go back to them). Unfortunately I am not able to share myself completely in a paragraph in the bulletin (no one can be summed up that way), so I encourage you to reach out to me and get to know me, as your pastor and just as the man God created me to be (I love food, so dinner invitations are always welcome!). I am excited to continue growing as a priest and the man God created me to be here at this wonderful parish! Please do not hesitate to reach out to me anytime as I am here for you (as you are also here for me: we are a parish family) and I look forward to begin ministry and sharing the light and love of Christ through my priestly ministry here at St. Laurence O'Toole!
