

Vocation Poster Contest Q & A

What are the dimensions of the poster?

Posters should be no smaller than 8.5 x 11 and no larger than 11 x 17.

What type of art medium may be used?

All posters should be hand-drawn, which consists of artwork that uses pencil, paint, markers, crayons, etc.

What should be included in the poster?

Students are encouraged to use Scripture verses, slogans, catchy phrases, or other words to highlight the promotion of vocations.

How will the poster be judged?

Teachers/catechists can use the rubric to give their students a grade. The contest judges will base winners on creativity, craftsmanship, effort, overall vocation message, and overall poster appearance.

How do we submit entries?

To submit the posters, <u>mail</u> them to the <u>Office of Vocations</u>, 1553 Golden Gate Ave., Los Angeles, 90026. Please ensure that each entry has the student's name, school, and grade on the back of the poster.

When are the posters due?

All entries must be submitted to the Office of Vocations by Friday, December 12th.

When will we find out the winners?

Announcements of winners will take place by the end of January.

How can you be disqualified from the contest?

Include your <u>Name</u>, <u>Last Name</u>, <u>grade</u>, and <u>School</u> on the back of your artwork; <u>otherwise</u>, <u>your poster will be disqualified</u>.
