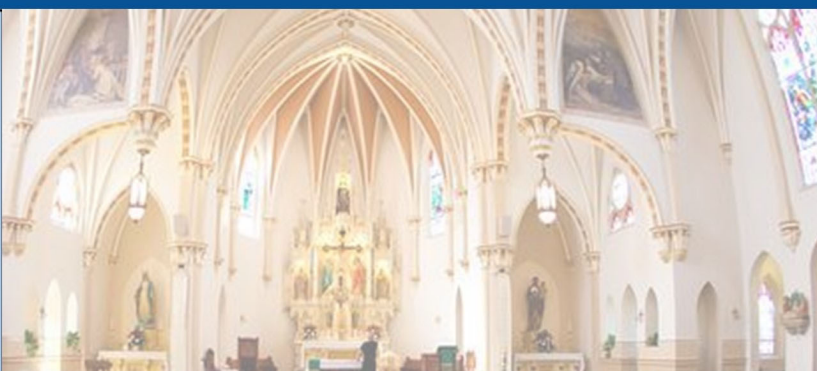

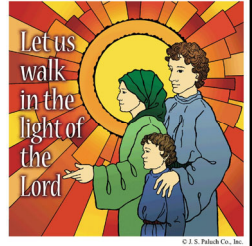

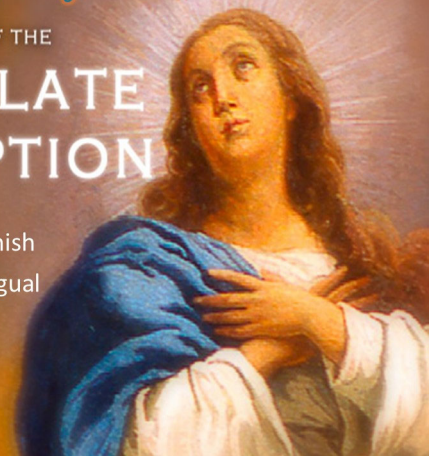

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:



Dear Parishioners:

Greetings from the ice! All continues to go well down here at the bottom of the world at Camp McMurdo. Currently, there are about 950 personnel here, including our team of ANG Airmen who are mostly working on the ice and snow flight line day and night. Camp McMurdo was established by the US Navy in 1956 and it has continued to serve for well over 60 years as the largest research station in all of Antarctica. It is the world's southernmost port when it is free of ice. Speaking of ships, there are several vessels that will arrive at the station in late January long after I depart. First will come the Polar Star, a USCG ice breaker, and following along - directly from Port Hueneme - will come an oiler and then a freighter to restock supplies for the coming year. The Camp McMurdo - Port Hueneme connection is strong, and it is my understanding that members of the Naval Construction Battalion, (Seabees) at Port Hueneme constructed the original Chapel of the Snows, using spare and scrap parts from other buildings. That original chapel burned down, and the one below is the current chapel where I am located.

Wishing you all a most Blessed Thanksgiving weekend and I look forward to returning soon to be with you most of Advent and Christmas,

¿SABÍA USTED?

Tendencia peligrosa de TikTok: "pollo dormido".

La Administración de Alimentos y Medicamentos (FDA, por sus siglas en inglés) emitió recientemente un aviso que advierte a las personas que no participen en una tendencia peligrosa de TikTok: cocinar pollo en NyQuil, un medicamento para el resfriado nocturno. Según videos en el popular sitio de redes sociales, la gente está cocinando "pollo dormido" como un desafío, pero la advertencia de la FDA indica que puede ser más que una broma inofensiva. Cocinar con medicamentos para la tos puede hacer que una persona ingiera cantidades peligrosamente altas de codeína que pueden causar complicaciones de salud graves e incluso la muerte.
