

On the feast day of our patron saint, Saint Therese of Lisieux, we will have a Coffee Reception and a Blessing & Dedication of an original work of art entitled *Ste. Therese of Lisieux*, *The Little Flower* created by the late Leo Cormier. This magnificent piece of artwork is a 4'x6' calligraphy that beautifully depicts the historical life of one of the most popular modern saints in the world.
