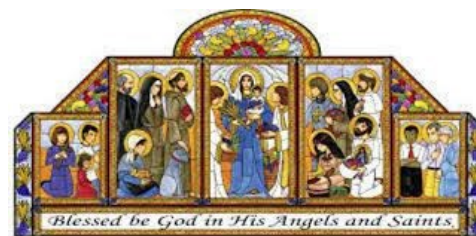

Crazy Catholic Men

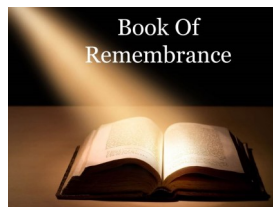
