

Again this week we hear of Paul and his companion Barnabas, speaking out boldly and with conviction about the word of God. When they met opposition among their ancestors, they took their message to the Gentile communities. The key to evangelization is in the last line in that first reading: "The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit." Their commitment grew stronger!

When people turn a deaf ear to us about following Jesus' example or about the joy that our relationship with Christ gives us, we are reminded to recall the words Jesus says to us in the gospel - "My sheep hear my voice . . . and follow me." This week share the good news with one other person and notice the joy it gives you, and them.

Our 3rd Thursday coffee and donuts returns this Thursday following the 9am Mass at St. Theresa.


