## Pastor's Desk

### 11. Mass – The Creed

**Content** –The Creed is a summary statement of the faith used in the early Church as a standard for Christian belief. The Creed summarizes the story of Scripture. Moving from creation to Christ's incarnation, death and resurrection, to the sending of the Holy Spirit, to the era of the Church, and finally to the Second Coming, the Creed carries us through the entire story of salvation history. The Creed also presumes that this divine plan was fully revealed in God's Son, the "one Lord Jesus Christ" who "became man" to show us the pathway to happiness and eternal life. The Creed also notes how Jesus came "for us men and for our salvation" and to bring "forgiveness of sins." The Creed reminds us that at the end of our lives we will stand before the Lord Jesus Christ who "will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead." At that moment, all our life choices will be weighed in a balance before the divine judge, and we will receive our just reward or punishment for how we lived.

**Catechism** –According to the Catechism, there are two aspects of belief. On the one hand, belief is something intellectual. It is "a free assent to the whole truth that God has revealed." We affirm our belief that there is "one God," that Jesus is "the only begotten son of God" and that he died and rose again on the third day. We also believe in "the Holy Spirit" and "one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church" to which our minds give assent in all that she officially teaches. On the other hand, even more fundamental to faith is its being "personal adherence...to God". It also means a personal entrusting of one's life to God. It expresses how God is truly the foundation for my life. The singular "I," makes the Creed more personal and challenges each individual to interiorize the faith. As the Catechism explains, "I believe" expresses "the faith of the Church professed personally by each believer."

**Biblical Theology** –He is the maker "of all things visible and invisible," referred to the creation of all things "in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible" (Col 1:16). The Christological language "consubstantial with the Father" closely reflects the theological language of the Council of Nicea which clarified that the son was "of the same substance" as the Father. The Creed's statement about Jesus' unique conception, "by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man" refers to "the fact that Son of God assumed a human nature in order to accomplish our salvation." According to John's gospel, it refers to "The word became flesh" (Jn 1:14). The Son of God was not just born of the Virgin Mary. The Eternal Son of God who is of the same substance as the Father actually took on human flesh for our salvation.
