

TO SCHEDULE A BAPTISM OR A QUINCEAÑERAS

Contact the Parish Office as soon as possible. <u>ALL</u> requirements listed below <u>Must</u> be met and submitted <u>BEFORE</u> the date will be set on the calendar. Please no less than 4 months in advance for either request.

Requirements of Cannon Law:

- ◆ Godparents **must have** received all of the Sacraments of initiation-**Baptism**, **First Communion & Confirmation**.
- <u>If married</u>, godparents should be <u>married in the Catholic Church</u>.
- ♦ If parents or godparents are not members of this parish, a <u>letter of</u> recommendation from their pastor should be provided.
- Parents and godparents <u>must attend a baptismal preparation class</u>. If it has been less than 2 years since certification, please provide a copy of the certificate.

Required by the Parish: (copies of) —Birth certificate of the child to be baptized & copies of the ID's of parents & sponsor (s).
