In Today's Gospel

According to the Jewish tradition, there are 613 laws in the Torah, the first five books of the Bible. In addition, Jewish authorities imposed many more laws on top of Torah. I have no doubt that there was a lot of academic debate among the scholars of the law as to which of the laws were most important. In today's gospel, one of those scholars approaches Jesus to get his take on the question.

In his response, Jesus turns to the book of Deuteronomy, but he does not quote Deuteronomy exactly. Deuteronomy tells us to love the Lord, "with all your heart, and with all your soul, with all your strength." (Deut. 6:5) Jesus agrees with this, but he adds something to it. Jesus tells us that we are to love the Lord with all our minds, in addition to our heart, soul, and strength.

Our love and our obedience to God is not to be a thoughtless, blind love and obedience. It must be freely chosen. To choose something freely, we must know what it is; we must use our reason and minds to understand what we are choosing. God wants us to love him, not because we have to, but because we want to.

Grace

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, grace is "The free and undeserved gift that God gives us to respond to our vocation to become his adopted children." (Glossary). Although grace is freely given to us by God, God does not force himself on us. We must respond to his grace. One of the ordinary means by which we receive God's grace is through the sacraments.

There are seven sacraments: baptism, confirmation, the Eucharist, reconciliation, marriage, holy orders, and anointing of the sick. In the coming weeks I will introduce each of the sacraments, beginning with the sacrament of baptism.

The Sacrament of Baptism

The first sacrament we receive is baptism. It is through baptism that we first receive God's sanctifying grace. Jesus made it clear that baptism is necessary for salvation, saying, "Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit." (Jn 3:5)

Baptism, along with the sacraments of confirmation and Eucharist, is one of the "sacraments of initiation." It is through the sacrament of baptism that we enter the Church. Without baptism, we cannot receive any of the other sacraments.

In the sacrament of baptism, we are washed clean from sin. That includes original sin and any personal sin that we may have committed before our baptism. Through the waters of baptism, we pass from slavery to sin and death to freedom as God's children. This was foreshadowed in the Old Testament when the children of Israel passed through the Red Sea, moving from slavery in Egypt to the freedom of God's children. In the waters of baptism, we die with Christ and are reborn to eternal life.

In the Catholic Church, the sacrament of baptism is usually received as an infant. Jesus said, "no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and spirit," this includes children. In the great commission, when Jesus told us to "Go, therefore, make disciples of all nations," the first thing he told us to do was to baptize them "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit." (Mt 28:19) We must first baptize, then we must teach them to observe all that Christ commanded us.

The introduction to Order of Baptism of Children states that the "celebration of baptism should take place during the first weeks after the birth of the child." (8) If there is a danger of death, they may even be baptized in the hospital.

Christ gave us the sacraments as the ordinary means for our salvation. This, however, does not limit God's grace. God's grace is available to us at all times if we are willing to receive it.

LIFESPAN NEWS:

Recently the question came up, why do Christian girls obtain abortions? Several answers were forthcoming... and they mostly concern the undue psychological pressure these girls face when they become pregnant, and the corresponding lack of communication and support from those around them.

Communication between parents and their sons and daughters is always a challenge, even more so as they become teenagers and test their independence. Parents today need fortitude, honesty and love to be able to discuss the hard topic of unwanted pregnancies and abortions with their children. Often there is a piece missing from the talks parents have with their children: how to leave the door open to them should they stray without seeming to condone pre-marital relations.

Sometimes there is actually an unspoken message that the plans put into place for a child's future, a college education and career, just don't allow for "mistakes to happen".

In addition, there may also be the fear on the part of the girl that if she doesn't abort, she may lose the father of her child, as he may threaten to abandon both her and their child unless she has an abortion.

In a very subtle and insidious way these perceived pressures and fears may actually take away any real choice the young girl may have had. Children need to know in life that even if they stray in ANY capacity, that they can always turn to their parents. Christian parents may make good, strong cases for purity before marriage... and yet neglect to communicate the message of grace: that they are there for them no matter what, and that if they make a mistake- in this case by getting pregnant - it is safer for them to seek them out for help and support. Today more than ever, Christian children need to hear those supportive and reassuring words from their Christian parents.
