In Today's Gospel

"This saying is hard; who can accept it?" This week, we returned to the Gospel of John for our final installment of Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist. Jesus has told his disciples, and us, that he is the living bread that comes down from heaven, and that "whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (Jn 6:51) In today's gospel, many of those who heard Jesus rejected his teaching.

Much of what Jesus teaches us is difficult. Unfortunately, many of us, like those in the gospel, reject the teachings we find difficult. This is especially true today in the area of sexual morality. That which we do not like, we reject. Unfortunately, if we reject the teachings of Jesus, then we reject Jesus himself.

Faith Formation

At the end of the baptismal rite, the Order of Baptism of Children gives us three prayers of blessing; for the mother, the father, and all of the faithful present. In those prayers, we pray that they might be effective teachers and witnesses of the faith to the child. In particular, we pray for fathers "that, together with their wives, they may, by word and example, prove to be the first witnesses of the faith to their children, in Christ Jesus our Lord." (70) It is you, mom and dad, who are responsible for teaching your children to be a Christian, but you are not alone; the Church is here to help.

In addition to Mass, the Church helps parents through our Faith Formation programs. Thanks to the dedication of our volunteers and catechists, we are able to provide Faith Formation classes for the children in our parishes

It's not too late to sign up for Faith Formation. We are still accepting registrations. If you have children from 1st through 8th grade and have not yet signed up, please go to www.stmarywayne.org to register. This is important for teaching our children the details of our faith, but it is not a replacement for the daily witness to the Christian life provided by parents.

Equipping Parents to Proclaim the Faith

As stated above, parents are the first teachers and witnesses to the faith for their children, but the Church is here to help. We have added a new component to our Faith Formation program this year to aid parents in their responsibilities as Christian witnesses. On the second Monday of each month, beginning on October 11th, we will be offering a class for all parents, "Equipping Parents to Proclaim the Faith." This program is a simple overview and discussion about our faith, and while it is required for all parents with children in Faith Formation, it is open to all parishioners in our family of parishes

Faith Formation begins in a few weeks. I look forward to seeing your children—and you—as we continue our journey with Christ.

Men at Work

For the last couple of months, you may have noticed the radiator covers removed in the church at St. Mary. This is part of a project that has been going on throughout the church and the school to replace the steam traps in our heating system. Steam traps are essential to the proper operation of the system. Many of our steam traps have not been serviced in decades.

Throughout this summer, our maintenance staff (including Kelly Kelemen and Richard Debellefeuille, our business manager, Albert Damitio, and a volunteer parishioner, Hector Lebert) have been working to replace over 100 steam traps. Some traps are easy to reach, such as those in the church, but some have required crawling on their bellies in the tunnels under the school and church.

Working with Consumers Power, we received a grant to cover most of the material costs for this project. By doing the work ourselves, we have saved St. Mary a good deal of money. Thank you to all those who helped with this project. This project will allow our system to run more effectively and efficiently, resulting in long-term savings for our parish.

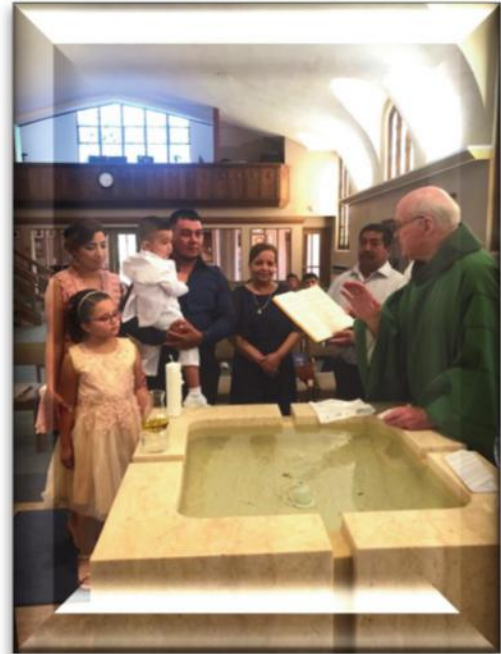

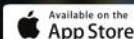
