#### In Today's Gospel

Jesus came to bring salvation to all. In today's gospel, Jesus is preaching to the Gentiles. He prays over the deaf-mute and cries out "Ephphatha!" which means be opened. This miracle is about more than curing a man's deafness and his inability to speak. It is about being opened to receive the word of God and proclaim that word to the world.

In the Order of Baptism of Children, one of the optional prayers is the Ephphatha prayer. While touching the child's ears and mouth (don't worry, I don't spit), the priest says, "May the Lord Jesus, who made the deaf to hear and the mute to speak, grant that you may soon receive his word in your ears and profess the faith with your lips, to the glory and praise of God the father." (101)

If we are to proclaim God's word, as we are all called to do, we must first receive that word. Let us pray that our ears and our hearts will be open to receive God's word.

#### Happy Birthday!!!

On December 8th, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On this day, we celebrate the conception of Mary in her mother's womb. Although Mary was conceived in the normal way between her parents, Ss. Joachim and Anne, the Church teaches us that from the first moment of her conception, Mary was preserved from the stain of original sin by the saving merits of Jesus Christ.

Wednesday is September 8th, nine months after the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. On this day, we celebrate the birth of Mary. (Although I checked a few resources, I could not find a reason for the dates). Neither the conception nor the birth of Mary are recorded in Scripture. Some ancient sources speak about these events, but the earliest of them date to the mid-second century. Although they may be worthy of devotional reading, they cannot be considered as inspired by God. Suffice to say, we do know that Mary was born, and September 8th is as good as any day to celebrate her birthday, so happy birthday Mary.


