In Today's Gospel

What leads you into sin? Does watching the evening news lead you into sin? Do you watch the evening news and get so upset that it causes that anger to burn in your heart, leading you to hatred of those with whom you disagree? If so, perhaps you should cut off the evening news.

Does surfing the Internet lead you into sin? Do you get so lost on the Internet that you waste hours that should be put to better use? Have you stolen time from your employer because you are surfing when you should be working? Have you allowed the Internet to lead you into pornography and perversion? If so, perhaps you should cut off the Internet.

In today's gospel, Jesus calls us to evaluate the things in our life that lead us into sin. He tells us that we should seek to cut away those things that are the source of sin in our lives. In the modern age, the idea of cutting off the Internet may seem just as ridiculous as cutting off a hand or a foot. While I do not think Jesus wanted us to cut off our limbs literally, he does call on us to cut sin out of our lives. Perhaps we can find a balance in our Internet usage but are all called to a radical conversion in our lives so that we may cut off all that separates us from Christ.

The Month of the Rosary

This week, we begin the month of October, the month of the Rosary. While praying the rosary is a good practice at all times, we are called in a particular way to pray the rosary during October.

The rosary is a prayer containing 153 Hail Marys. The first three Hail Marys are dedicated to the Holy Trinity; the remaining 150 correspond to the 150 Psalms. The Hail Marys are broken up into groups of 10, called decades. While praying each decade, we should meditate on the ministries of the life of Christ, seen through the eyes of his mother. In between each decade, we pray one Our Father and one Glory Be. We begin the rosary with the Apostles' Creed and end with the Hail Holy Queen. Traditionally, the rosary is divided into three groups of five decades corresponding to the Joyful Mysteries, the Sorrowful Mysteries, and the Glorious Mysteries. In 2002 St. John Paul the II added a fourth set of ministries, the Luminous Mysteries.

Tradition has it that the rosary was given to St. Dominic in the 13th century as he struggled to overcome the Albigensian heresy. During the 16th century, while Europe was caught in the grips of Protestant Reformation, the Ottoman Empire seized on division in Christianity to spread Islam into Europe. Rallying to the defense of Christendom, in 1571, the naval forces of the Holy League (a coalition of the Catholic powers of southern Europe) sailed forth to engage the Ottoman forces. Recognizing the distinct material disadvantages of the Christian forces, Pope Pius V called for all of Europe to pray the rosary for victory.

On October 7, 1571, the Christian and Muslim armadas met at the Battle of Lepanto, one of the greatest naval battles in history. Despite their disadvantages, through the intercession of the Blessed Mother, the Christian forces were victorious in putting an end to Islamic expansion into Europe.

In honor of the victory at Lepanto, October 7th was instituted as the feast of Our Lady of Victory; today, it is known as the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Let us turn to the Our Lady of the Rosary as we pray for victory over sin in our lives.
