# Epiphany of the LORD

## Notes from Fr. Sean

### In Today's Gospel

Today, we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. In today's gospel, the Magi, having traveled a great distance to pay homage to the newborn King of the Jews, see something special in this child born to humble circumstances. Even when confronted with difficulty and deception and not fully understanding what they are doing, they continue to follow God's direction.

Jesus was rejected by the leaders of his own people but embraced by these Gentiles. As we begin the New Year, let us be open to Christ. Let us welcome him into our lives in whatever form he may appear. Let us be open to new experiences and new people.

### The Solemnity of Mary and the Epiphany of the Lord

This weekend, there are two holy days. On Saturday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God (January 1). On Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany (the Sunday between January 2 and 8). Because the Solemnity of Mary falls on a Saturday, the obligation to attend Mass has been waived.

According to the Merriam-Webster online dictionary, the word epiphany means: "a usually sudden manifestation or perception of the essential nature or meaning of something" or "an appearance or manifestation especially of a divine being." In Christianity, it refers to a revelation of Jesus Christ to the world. While in the Western Church, the Epiphany is most closely associated with the visit of the Magi, it actually refers to three events in the life of Christ: 1) the visit of the Magi, which we celebrate today; 2) the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River, which we celebrate next Sunday; and 3) the wedding feast at Cana which saw Jesus perform his first public miracle, which we remember the following Sunday.

In each of these events, Jesus is made manifest to the world. It is tragic that his own people did not recognize Jesus and even sought to destroy him while the first people to pay him homage were those on the fringes of Jewish society, the shepherds and outsiders, the Magi. God has come to bring salvation to all who are willing to accept him. He comes to us in many ways, often in ways that we do not expect, understand, or even desire. To receive him, we must approach him with hearts and minds open.

### Epiphany House Blessing

The Magi from the East came to the home of Mary and Joseph and presented them with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. In this, these holy men from the East offered a blessing to the home of the Holy Family. Traditionally we remember this event by blessing our own homes on the feast of the Epiphany. This blessing takes the form of saying prayers and writing the initials 20 + C + B + M + 22, with a piece of chalk, over the doors of our homes.

The numbers are a reference to the year. The letters refer to the traditional names given to the Magi: Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar and the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, which means "May Christ bless this home." In doing this, not only do we bless our homes, but we announce to the world that "this is a Christian home."

### Happy New Year!

On behalf of St. Mary and St. Richard parishes' staff and volunteers, I want to wish all of you a happy, safe, and prosperous new year. We continued to face challenges in 2021. Let us pray that in 2022 we will see the dawn of light and health throughout the world.

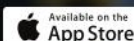
