Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

Sometimes, when we pray, we do not see the results of our prayers, and we get impatient. We may even begin to lose faith. I know the frustration of praying for something I want but not getting it the way I want. I often speak with parents or grandparents who are praying for their children or grandchildren but do not see the results of their prayer.

Sometimes we see the results of our prayers, but sometimes we do not. When we fail to see results, we grow frustrated and impatient. Our readings today call us to be faithful to God and persistent in our prayers.

In today's gospel, we see the parable of the persistent widow. She went up against a corrupt, dishonest judge. The dishonest judge had no interest in rendering a just judgment for her, but he eventually rendered a just decision because of her persistence. We must remain faithful to God and have confidence his will be fulfilled, even if we do not see that fulfillment.

En el evangelio de hoy

A veces, cuando oramos, no vemos los resultados de nuestras oraciones y nos impacientamos. Incluso podemos comenzar a perder la fe. Conozco la frustración de orar por algo que quiero pero no obtenerlo de la manera que quiero. A menudo hablo con padres o abuelos que están orando por sus hijos o nietos pero no ven los resultados de su oración.

A veces vemos los resultados de nuestras oraciones, pero a veces no. Cuando no vemos resultados, nos frustramos e impacientamos. Nuestras lecturas de hoy nos llaman a ser fieles a Dios y persistentes en nuestra oración.

En el evangelio de hoy, vemos la parábola de la viuda persistente. Se enfrentó a un juez corrupto y deshonesto. El juez deshonesto no tenía interés en dictar un juicio justo por ella, pero finalmente dictó una decisión justa debido a su persistencia. Debemos permanecer fieles a Dios y tener confianza en que su voluntad se cumplirá, aunque no veamos ese cumplimiento.

The Fruits of Persistence

In 1973, a great injustice was done in our nation. It became legal to take the life of a child in its mother's womb. For 49 years, we prayed for this injustice to be undone. This year, we saw the fruit of our persistence in prayer. Now, the battle to defend life has moved from the federal level to the state level. We must continue to pray and to work for an end to abortion.

Los frutos de la persistencia

En 1973 se cometió una gran injusticia en nuestra nación. Se hizo legal tomar la vida de un niño en el vientre de su madre. Durante 49 años oramos para que se deshiciera esta injusticia. Este año vimos el fruto de nuestra persistencia en la oración. Ahora, la batalla por defender la vida ha pasado del nivel federal al estatal. Debemos continuar orando y trabajando por el fin del aborto.

Proposal 3

There is currently a proposal on the Michigan ballot that seeks to enshrine abortion in our state constitution and goes far beyond. Proposal 3 would allow any type of abortion, including partial-birth abortion, at any time during the pregnancy, including up until the moment before birth. Proposal 3 would eliminate laws requiring parental consent for medical treatment related to pregnancy, including sterilization and hormone therapy. Proposal 3 is too extreme and must be stopped. Vote No on 3.

Propuesta 3

Actualmente hay una propuesta en la boleta electoral de Michigan que busca consagrar el aborto en la constitución de nuestro estado y va mucho más allá. La Propuesta 3 permitiría cualquier tipo de aborto, incluido el aborto por nacimiento parcial, en cualquier momento del embarazo, incluso hasta el momento previo al parto. La Propuesta 3 eliminaría las leyes que requieren el consentimiento de los padres para el tratamiento médico relacionado con el embarazo, incluida la esterilización y la terapia hormonal. La propuesta 3 es demasiado extrema y debe detenerse. Vota No a la 3.
