THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD

Notes from Fr. Sean

In Today's Gospel

We have lots of options for our readings today. In today's gospels, we may hear Matthew's genealogy of Jesus, beginning with Abraham, or from John, who simply states, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." All history before Christ looks forward to Christ, and all history after, looks back to Christ, to his birth, death, and resurrection, the central point of all history.

We may also hear from Luke, who speaks of angels, shepherds, and a child born in humble circumstances, wrapped in swaddling clothes. All these Gospels and readings lead us to Jesus Christ, our God and Creator, who entered his creation to lead us back to the Father. Let us look to Jesus Christ and sing praise to God, saying, "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."

En el Evangelio de Hoy

Tenemos muchas opciones para nuestras lecturas de hoy. En los evangelios de hoy, podríamos escuchar la genealogía de Jesús de Mateo, comenzando con Abraham, o de Juan, quien simplemente declara: "En el principio existía la Palabra y la Palabra estaba junto a Dios, y la Palabra era Dios". Toda la historia anterior a Cristo mira hacia Cristo, y toda la historia posterior mira hacia atrás a Cristo, a su nacimiento, muerte y resurrección, el punto central de toda la historia.

También podríamos escuchar a Lucas, quien habla de ángeles, pastores y un niño nacido en circunstancias humildes, envuelto en pañales. Todos estos Evangelios y lecturas nos llevan a Jesucristo, nuestro Dios y Creador, quien entró en su creación para llevarnos de vuelta al Padre. Miremos a Jesucristo y cantemos alabanzas a Dios, diciendo: "Gloria a Dios en las alturas y en la tierra paz a los hombres en quienes él se complace".

**Tax Advantage: Ways to Give to Our Parish**

Parishioners may consider these two ways to lower their tax bill through charitable giving at the year end..

Gifts of Appreciated Securities

Gifts of Appreciated Securities continue to be beneficial for donors since they offer significant tax advantages including income tax deductions and avoidance of tax on capital gains if the donor sells the highly appreciated securities. With markets remaining at high levels in spite of recent volatility, many parishioners likely have some highly appreciated securities in their portfolios. Through a gift of appreciated securities to benefit our parish, including through the Catholic Services Appeal, donors who itemize may receive an income tax deduction up to the full market value of the securities and can also avoid capital gains tax on the appreciation. In essence, you may save twice – on income tax and capital gains tax.

Please consult your tax, legal or accounting advisor before engaging in any transaction.

IRA Rollover – Qualified Charitable Distribution

The IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) provides a way for donors 70 ½ and older to receive a tax benefit for their generosity. It is beneficial because the QCD will not be included in adjusted gross income and is, therefore, not subject to tax. This is now more beneficial in view of the increased standard deduction in the new tax law. A donor can make a QCD of up to \$100,000 annually directly from the IRA to a charity, and as an added benefit, the QCD satisfies the donor's required minimum distribution. Parishioners 70 ½ or older should consult with their IRA administrator for the procedure to make a QCD to our parish.

On Friday, December 9th, some of St. Mary 7th & 8th youth and their parents participated in a Vicariate Los Posadas Advent Service Project between St Thomas, Divine Child, and Sacred Heart Church looking for a room at the inn. 
